



A TYPICAL DAY IN THE LIFE OF A DRIVER

1. Check out truck (may involve some climbing).
 - a. In and out of cab at least twice.
2. Pulls truck over to loading area.
 - a. In and out of cab at least once.
3. Pulls truck under plant and fills water tank.
 - a. In and out of cab at least twice.
4. Places grocery items on the truck which are located near the plant or in the warehouse (i.e. fibermesh, sealer, expansion joint, or tools – 25 to 100 lbs.)
5. Pulls truck from underneath plant to wash down
 - a. In and out of cab once.
 - b. Up and Down ladder once.
6. Drive Truck to job site – Traveling time anywhere between 10 & 30 minutes.
7. Pulls on job site.
 - a. In and out of cab to position truck on job site when necessary
 - b. Place chutes on truck mixer when necessary
 - c. Pour concrete
 - d. Move truck when necessary
 - e. Wash down mixer
 - i. In and out of cab once.
 - ii. Up and Down ladder once.
8. Drive truck back to yard and repeat cycle beginning with #2.
9. When necessary, other miscellaneous duties may include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Shoveling and Sweeping
 - b. Climbing into plant
 - c. Washing interior and exterior of truck
 - d. Pour interlocking concrete blocks
